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### **2. Introduction**

The *Orientation-cum-Recruitment Program* for the session 2025–26 was organized by the Economics and Finance Club, Finanza, with the objective of introducing new students to the club's vision, structure, and areas of work. The event aimed to familiarize first-year and second-year students with the functioning of the club while providing them with an overview of opportunities available within various finance-related domains.

The session was designed to serve as both an orientation and an initial screening platform, ensuring that interested students gained clarity about the club's expectations, culture, and learning environment before becoming part of the organization.

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### 3. Event Highlights

**Description:**

The event commenced at 5:00 PM with a strong turnout of students. The core team introduced the Economics and Finance Club, highlighting its mission, past initiatives, and future roadmap. Students were briefed on the club's internal structure, working verticals, and learning opportunities.

A short introductory workshop was conducted by the club secretaries, focusing on fundamental financial concepts and providing an overview of various sectors within finance. This session helped participants gain preliminary exposure to finance-related topics and understand the skill sets required for active involvement in the club.

The recruitment process concluded with student interactions and evaluations, following which selected candidates were onboarded into the club.

**Activities:**

The event comprised the following activities:

- Orientation session introducing the club's mission and functioning
- Introductory workshop on basic finance concepts
- Overview of different sectors and career paths in finance
- Recruitment and selection of new members

**Participation:**

The event recorded a total footfall of over **72 students**, including **64 first-year students** and **8 second-year students**. A total of **52 students** were successfully recruited into the club through this event.
