Description:

Activities:

The event included:

- **Explanation of rules:** The rules and format of the event were explained clearly to all participants before the start.
- **Acting and guessing:** In each team, one member picked the chit and acted out the given city name in chit.
- **Two rounds:** The event was conducted in two rounds with increasing difficulty to maintain interest and competition.
- **Final evaluation:** Teams were evaluated based on correct guesses and overall performance.
- **Creative Aspects:** The event encouraged creativity by allowing participants to express city names and cultural clues through actions and gestures without using words. Participants used facial expressions, body movements, and innovative acting styles to convey their clues.
