#### INTRODUCTION:

Filmy Funda was a creatively designed event that combined the learning experience of a **film-making workshop** with the competitive excitement of a **screenplay writing competition**, offering participants a comprehensive exposure to the art and craft of cinema. The event aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical storytelling and practical filmmaking skills by allowing students to both learn and apply cinematic concepts.

The first segment of the event focused on a **film-making workshop**, where participants were introduced to the fundamentals of visual storytelling. The session covered essential aspects such as idea development, screenplay structure, cinematography basics, direction techniques, camera framing, and the importance of sound and editing in filmmaking. Industry insights and practical examples helped attendees understand how creative ideas are transformed into impactful visual narratives.

Following the workshop, participants engaged in a **screenplay writing competition**, where they were encouraged to implement the concepts learned during the session. Students showcased their creativity by developing original story ideas, structuring narratives, and writing engaging scripts within a given theme or time frame. The competition emphasized originality, storytelling ability, character development, and cinematic imagination.

#### Event description:

Event started at 10:30 am. Film making club coordinated with Rajasthan film collective to conduct a workshop on film making. This workshop was lead by **Dr. Suruchi Sharma** renowned film maker, director of award winning short film “**Gagan Gaman**” and have indulged herself in production of many other short films. Dr. Sharma explained complex

concepts through practical examples and real-life industry references, making the session engaging and easy to understand for beginners as well as aspiring filmmakers. She also emphasized the importance of creativity, teamwork, and effective storytelling in creating impactful films. The interactive nature of the workshop encouraged participants to ask questions, share ideas, and actively engage in discussions, thereby enriching their learning experience. The session successfully equipped attendees with foundational knowledge and inspired them to explore filmmaking as a creative medium.

The workshop continued till 12 noon, afterwards the screenplay writing competition took place which was played in the following format in which first of all students were given sheets and pens. Then they all were allowed to create a screenplay which was freely based on their creativity, there was no restriction of genre or any other catch in the competition. They all were given 30 minutes to write their screenplay. Students at starting were told the main judging criteria and the rules of the screenplay competition. After the completion of the competition the sheets were collected. These sheets were given to Dr Sharma who also was the judge for the event. She decided the three screenplays that she liked the most and announced the winners same day itself.

At the end of the event there was a hamper provided to Dr Suruchi Sharma from our film making club and refreshments were provided to all the people who participated in the workshop and the competition. We all clicked pictures to mark the end of the event.

### **Participation and engagement:**

A total of 40 members came to take the workshop and the screenplay competition. All of them were eagerly participating in the discussion on film making. These participants were none other than the film enthusiasts which are very small in number in a mass place as they are interested in the process how the film is made not like others who just watch films for entertainment.
