The Quiz Bowl was conducted as a fast-paced and energetic competition based on:

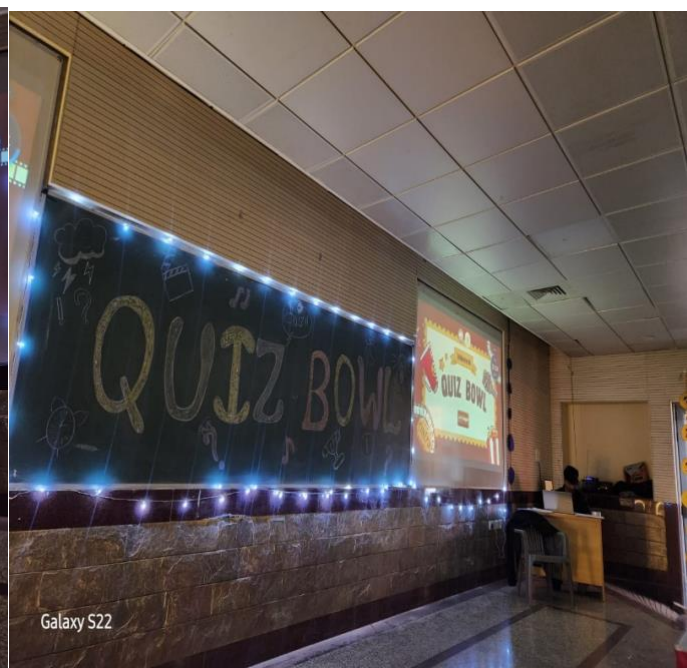
- Pop Culture
