2. Introduction

Mystery Palace was organized as a unique escape-style quiz event under Blitzschlag'26, where participants had to solve quizzes, riddles, and puzzles in a time-bound format. The event was designed to test logical thinking, observation skills, teamwork, and problem-solving ability in an engaging and interactive way.

Unlike a physical escape room, Mystery Palace focused on a mental escape experience, where teams progressed through multiple stages by unlocking clues, ultimately leading them to the final treasure box.

Event Theme: Escape-style puzzle and quiz challenge

Objective: To enhance teamwork, critical thinking, and puzzle-solving skills through an interactive treasure hunt format.

Target Audience: MNIT Jaipur students from all departments

3. Event Format / Rules & Guidelines

The event followed a team-based escape-style structure where teams competed one at a time. Participants solved quizzes, logic puzzles, riddles, and hidden clue-based tasks to progress through stages.

Event Format:

- Team-based escape-style quiz event
- Multiple stages with quizzes, riddles, logic puzzles & hidden clues
- Each stage unlocked the next
- Final stage revealed the Treasure Box
- One team played at a time

Team Size: 4–5 participants

Time Limit: 15–20 minutes per team



4. Event Highlights

Mystery Palace created an exciting atmosphere with its escape-room-inspired theme. Participants worked together under pressure, using logic and teamwork to solve puzzles and unlock stages. The event successfully kept teams engaged and competitive throughout the day.

Key Highlights:

- Escape-style quiz and puzzle-solving format
- Hidden clue challenges and stage unlocking system
- Time-based competitive gameplay
- Penalty-based hint system for fairness
- Treasure box finale for added excitement

5. Participation

The event witnessed strong participation from students across different departments. Number of participants were around 145 across two days. Teams actively registered and competed throughout both days. The escape-style format attracted enthusiastic participants and encouraged teamwork, coordination, and critical thinking.

6. Feedback and Suggestions

The event received very positive feedback from participants. Students enjoyed the escape-style format and appreciated the unique combination of quizzes, riddles, and logic puzzles. Many participants suggested organizing more such interactive events in future fests, with longer stages and more complex puzzle levels for an even more thrilling experience.
