2. Introduction

The QPL Auction Event was organized by the Quiz Club, MNIT Jaipur, to provide students with a thrilling and interactive experience inspired by professional sports auctions. The event was designed to combine quiz-based franchise selection with strategic bidding, team planning, and squad formation. It aimed to enhance competitive spirit, decision-making skills, and team coordination among participants while maintaining an entertaining and high-energy environment..

Event Theme: Strategy-Based Quiz Auction (QPL)

3. Event Highlights

Each player came with a base price and point rating, making the auction both strategic and competitive. Teams also selected a Captain and Vice-Captain to apply point multipliers, adding an extra layer of planning.

Activities Conducted:

- 20-question quiz round for franchise selection
- Live franchise-based auction session
- Squad formation based on quadrant rules



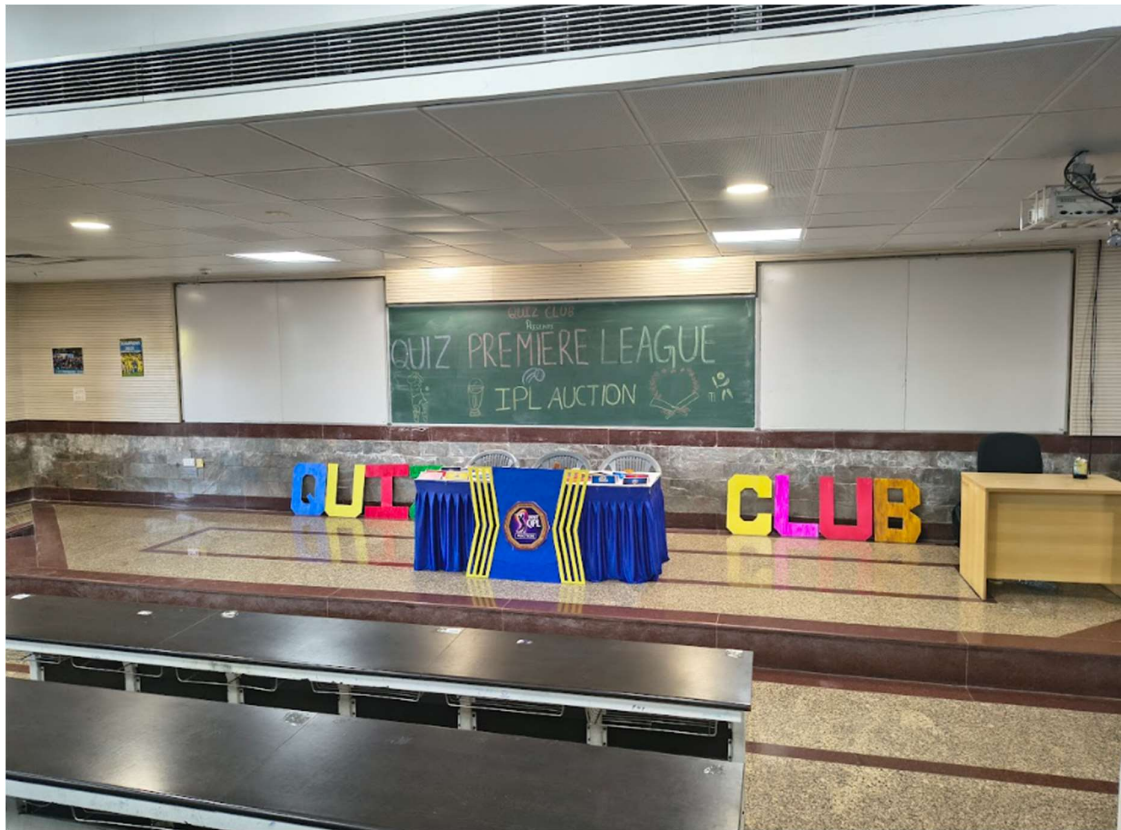
4. Participation

The event witnessed enthusiastic participation, active bidding wars, and strong teamwork throughout the session.
