The walk began from PMC and moved towards the Prabha Bhawan fountain, where participants learned about the role of shutter speed through a practical demonstration. Along the way, participants captured the aesthetic beauty of MNIT's campus, applying various compositional and technical techniques to enhance their photographs. The immersive experience not only strengthened their technical understanding but also deepened their appreciation and love for the serene and inspiring campus environment that surrounded them.
